In this study research find out the probability of selection of Khandesh region or specifically (Jalgaon, Dhule, Nandurbar) candidates in state services examination conducted by MPSC in 2011 to 2015.

The **Maharashtra Public Service Commission (MPSC)** is a body created by the Constitution of India to select applicants for civil service jobs in the Indian state of Maharashtra according to the merits of the applicants and the rules of reservation. The Head Office of the MPSC is located at the Maharashtra State Capital Mumbai.

Maharashtra Public Service Commission (MPSC) is a Constitutional Body established Under Article 315 of Constitution of India which provides a smooth and efficient functioning of the Government of Maharashtra by providing suitable candidates for various Government posts and advise them on various service matters like formulation of Recruitment Rules, advise on promotions, transfers and disciplinary actions etc.

All most all government recruitment is done under MPSC. MPSC is conducted recruitment process under 4 categories like competitive examination, departmental examination, direct recruitment or limited departmental examination. MPSC conducted recruitment for all public sector jobs which mainly include judicial magistrate, sales tax inspector, and state services clerk typist, engineering services, forest services, etc

The main purpose of MPSC is recruitment for the government recognized departments. In this research paper, study has been made about employment rate of Khandesh region candidates in various examination conducted by MPSC under state services examination which was conducted in between 2011 to 2015 years. This study is mainly focus on state services examination because this examination is not for any specific degree it is open to all graduated candidates, so the number of person who fill the examination form will be more. For that purpose 2011 to 2015 years result is downloaded from MPSC.org.in which will be available on the official website of Maharashtra public service commission and after that find out the probability of selection region wise in Khandesh region. As per given data it is found data Jalgaon having highest number of candidates who qualify the examination which was conducted by state services examination under MPSC.

Objective of this paper is make comparative an analysis of Khandesh region for to find the number of candidates qualify state services examination conducted by MPSC.

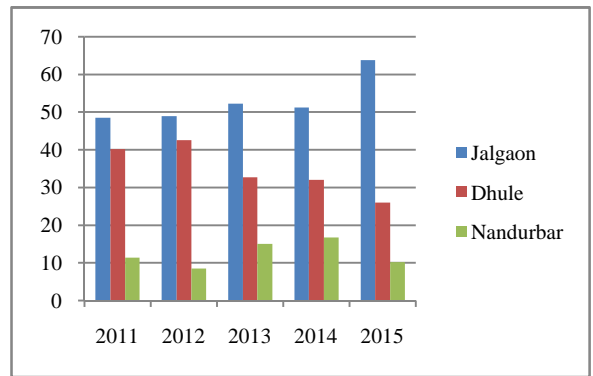
RESEARCH METHODOLOGY

DISCUSSION AND CONCLUSION

The main goal of this study was to examine the relationship of selection rate of khandesh region which include jalgaon, dhule, nandurbar with various examination conducted by MPSC under state services preliminary examination. As per the table1 its find out that form year 2011 to 2015 jalgaon districts have more number of candidates are qualify the examination conducted by MPSC or in summarized way from khandesh region 50 % of the candidates are selected from jalgaon district or remaining 50 % are selected form dhule nandurbar region collectively .

Above survey is mainly done for only khandesh region districts to find the selection rate or indirectly employment rate of jalgaon district is more in khandesh region and nandurbar district have averagely 10- 15 % candidates are qualify the examination from nandurbar district in khandesh region.In middle between them dhule district have 30-40 % passing rate in state services examination conducted by MPSC.

Overall discussion it is found out that Jalgaon having the highest number of candidates qualify the examination or indirectly they have more chances of selection in final phase of recruitment. So its satisfy first hypothesis means first hypothesis is proved. Nandurbar region candidates are less as compared to Jalgaon and Dhule district. Percentage wise only 10 -15 % candidates qualify the state services examination conducted by MPSC. It is indirectly say that less chances of selection in given examination means second hypothesis is also proved

As per the above discussion both hypothesis are satisfied.

Limitation

In the MPSC recruitment process is conducted in 3 stages first level preliminary examination then main examination and after that Interview. In the given study only state services preliminary examination result from2011 to 2015 years data is collected. Because preliminary examination is conducted districts wise which is easily gives the jalgaon, dhule, Nandurbar district data.

But Main examination is conducted region wise like Aurangabad, Mumbai, pune, Nagpur, Amravati, Nasik or etc. which was not specify the candidates exact location .so it doesn't give the exact idea about candidates district where it

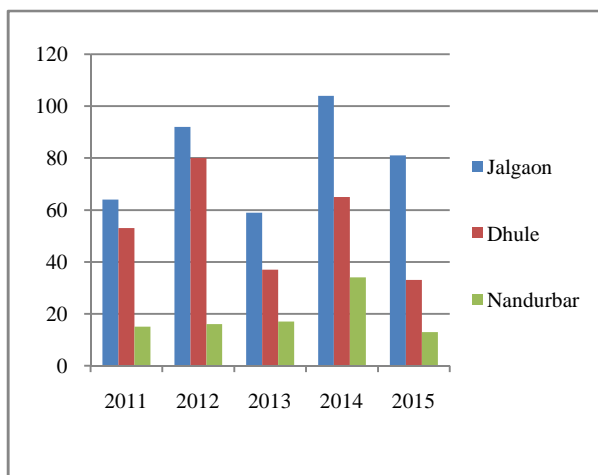
