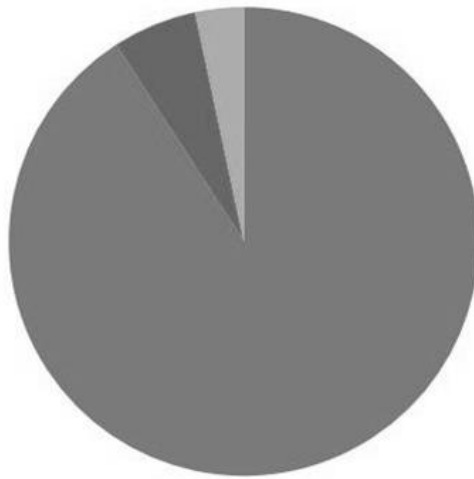

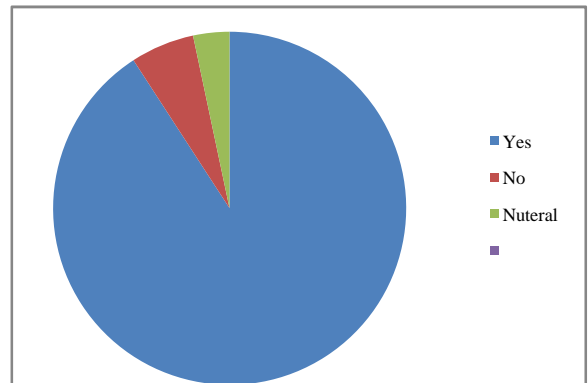
Data Collection

Is It really save the time to use this Schedule”

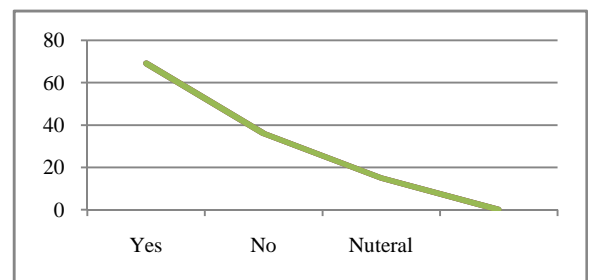

Is it really saving the money to use the Schedule?

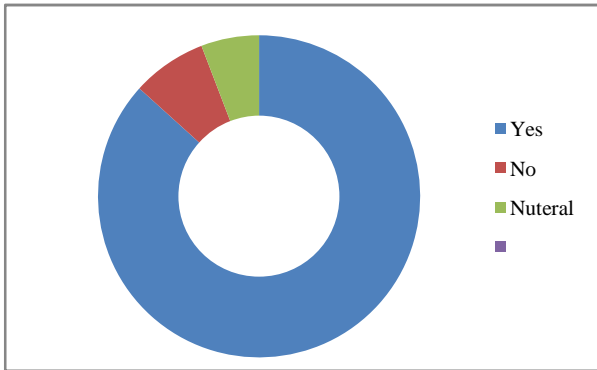

Is it helps to doing more jobs oriented?

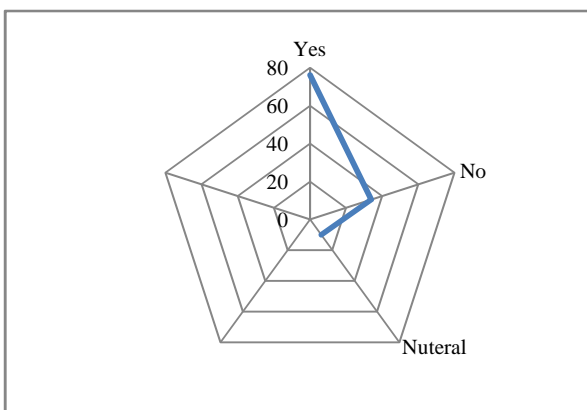

Is it helps us to avoid the tensions?

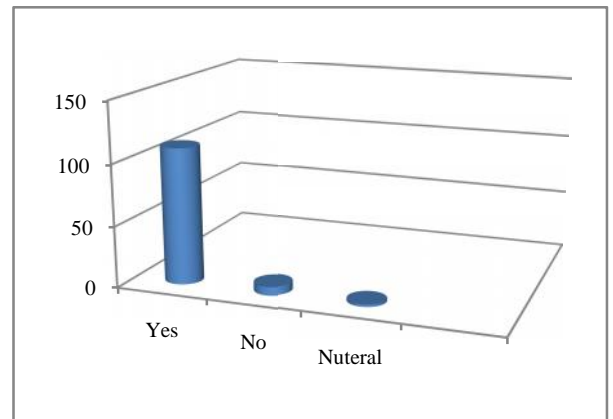

Is it regulating us to obey traffic rules?

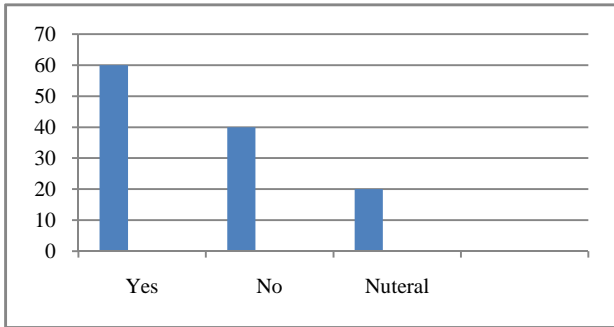

Is it giving more suitability in our life?

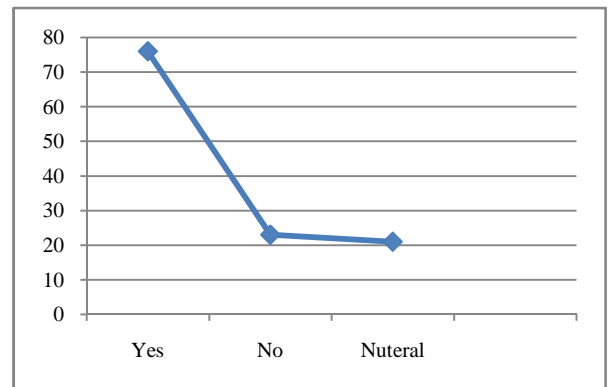

Is it helping us to use more resources?

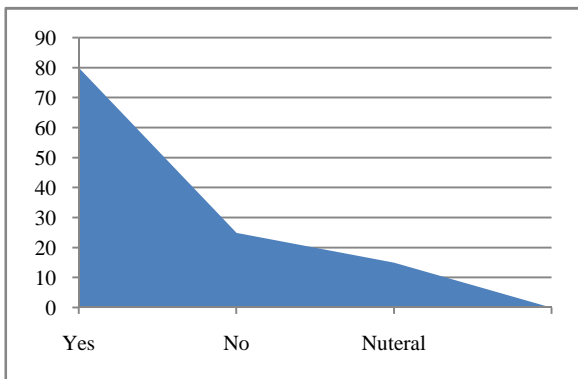

Is it providing more time to work in a proper way?

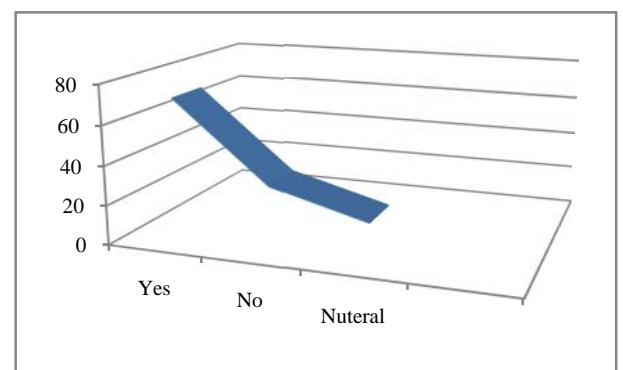
